## **Academic background:**

#### **Professional career:**

After graduating, I worked as a translator of Japanese literature as well as teaching translation theory and practice as an external lecturer at Aarhus University. This is what got me hooked on the language industry. This was followed by a short term employment at the Embassy of Denmark in Japan, acting as an international liaison and project manager to plan and execute a royal visit in 2017.

I was then hired into the language service provider "Xplanation", which was acquired by "LanguageWire" shortly after. Starting as a project manager, I have worked with coordinating and executing translation orders for a portfolio of manufacturing customers. Continuing into the role of Customer Success Manager, I have worked closely with customers to advise and streamline their localization setup and workflows. My current role as Strategic Solution Consultant in LanguageWire allows me to assist more broadly within the organization, advising other account owners on how best to advise their customers. Sometimes, I also step in to do a deeper discovery for our clients with a complex technical setup, making sure we can accommodate their needs.

### Professional experience in technical communication:

In my career in the language industry, I have worked primarily with technical and software clients, assisting them with translation of their documentation and apps/software. This means I have acquainted myself with DITA and topic-based authoring, and how this fits into localization technology. Integration and connectivity has also been a big topic in my customer conversations, with interconnectedness of systems only growing more and more. This complexity has been a drive for me, always striving to fully understand customer setups, the pains they are experiencing, and how they can best be solved.

#### Goals for my role as treasurer:

For the sake of transparency, my experience with tekom Denmark is limited, yet very fresh in mind. This year's Nordic TechKOMM was my first time participating, as my company had a presentation. That was my focus going in.
